



INFORMATIVE EX ART. 13 D. LGS. 196/2003

Dear Athlete,

According to the article 13 of the Legislative Decree n.196/2003, we inform You that the Organizing Committee, as treatment holder, during the first edition of the CISM Winter Military World Games, that will be held from 19th to 26th march 2010, will use some personal data concerning yourself in order to:

- Protect the Athletes' fundamental right to participate in doping-free sport and thus promote health, fairness and equality for Athletes worldwide;
- guarantee the application of harmonized, coordinated and effective anti-doping programs at the international and national level with regard to detection, deterrence and prevention of doping.

In particular, according to what decided in the laws of the State and the regulations concerning doping (International Anti-doping Code WADA together with the International Standards of controls and the Models of best practise) the CONI will treat the following personal data:

- A) Personal data and identification of the Athlete (name, surname, nationality, sex, sport and discipline, belonging organisations and federations, international level);
- B) Data concerning the exemptions for therapeutic reasons (TUE – Therapeutic Use Exemption) and the declaration of therapeutic use (DUT – Declaration of Use);
- C) Data concerning the exam of samples drawn during the controls in and out the competitions.

The points B and C can be considered “sensible”, as they concern data revealing the “health’s conditions” and concerning particular medical information, that can be discovered through the samples’ analysis and thanks to certifications concerning the exemptions for therapeutic reasons.

1. Data collecting

The data collecting is made with the help of electronic devices by the staff or by special structure designed by the Organizing Committee (for ex. CISM Anti-doping Commission, FMSI).

2. Mandatory data supply

The data supply, related to the present document, is mandatory and obligatory in order to participate to the mentioned organised sport event: the CISM first Winter Military World Games.

3. Data communication

According to the WADA Code, the data B), C) will be transmitted by the Organizing Committee to WADA – in Lausanne – and to the Athlete's International Federation.

4. Treatment holder

5. Right of access to personal data and other rights (ex. Art. 7 D. Lgs 196/2003)

During the Games, You can have free access to the personal data concerning Yourself at any moment, know how they have been obtained, verify if they are correct, updated and well protected. You have the right to make specific application and send it by recorded delivery letter to the treatment holder.
